Did you know that Massachusetts, along with Kentucky, Pennsylvania, and Virginia, is one of only four states that calls itself a "commonwealth"? Even though it's one of the smaller states (7th smallest in the U.S.), it still has about 7 million people living here! That's actually more than Tennessee but just a bit less than Arizona. It's also the most populated state in New England. Massachusetts has such a rich history as a part of America's story since the very first Pilgrims founded Plymouth Colony here in 1620. There's definitely something special about living in a place with so much history!

Massachusetts is full of unique towns and cities, and we're lucky to enjoy beer from three of them in the Greater Boston Area: Boston, Framingham, and Braintree! Boston, the oldest city in America, is packed with fascinating stories and "firsts" that'll impress any history buff. Braintree boasts its own impressive history as the birthplace of Presidents John Adams and John Quincy Adams, as well as John Hancock and General Sylvanus Thayer. It's also known as home to telephone co-inventor Thomas Watson. After the Revolutionary War, Framingham became a bustling stop on the Stage Coach line, sparking business growth in the center, while the steam engine later fueled industrial activity downtown. So much history in every corner!

Even though Massachusetts was the first state to put an end to afterwork happy hours and drink specials way back in 1984, that hasn't slowed down its booming brewery scene! In fact, it's been thriving, with new craft breweries popping up so fast it's hard to keep track. Boston, in particular, has an incredible beer scene with something for everyone, whether you're just dipping your toes into craft beer or are a full-on beer nerd. Iconic spots like Samuel Adams, one of the pioneers of the American craft beer movement, call Boston home.
